Richard B. Morrow is a principal of Transit Kabel TV, and, until its sale to Alltel in June 2006, was a principal of Virginia Cellular LLC. Virginia Cellular provided wireless service to over 35,000 customers in central Virginia. Transit Kabel TV provides cable television and internet access services, though fiber to the home, to 10,000 customers in suburban Stockholm, Sweden.

In addition to several leadership positions in the U.S. Capital Chapter of YPO, including Chapter Chair, Mr. Morrow has been a speaker at several wireless industry events, and most recently Co-Chair of the YPO Stanford Executive Program.

Prior to his involvement in Virginia Cellular and Transit Kabel, Mr. Morrow was an attorney with Lindsey, Hart, Neil & Weigler in Portland, Oregon and then with Venable, Baetjer, Howard & Civiletti in Washington, DC where, until 1987, he worked on early stage business structuring and financing.
